During the construction, the builders thought the massive wet rooms were extra bedrooms until the plumbers came to fit them out! All three large double bedrooms with en suite wet rooms with double sinks, bidets etc.

There are three other wash rooms, one for the pool, one for the guests, and one for the garage, so no expense was spared. The living area is also large with a kitchen, a fireplace, (for winter), and big TV that opens out onto the barbecue and pool area terrace.

Below them is the "garage level" with a 150,000 litre water tank that fills from the roof during winter (this equates to filling the pool twice!) This water is used for 'grey functions' like the toilets and the irrigation of the surrounding fruit trees and other trees and plants.

There is another "town water tank" which is in the system to cover when the normal water system is interrupted for any reason. It is a spacious double garage to keep cars out of the sun, with a mezzanine for general storage. It is also where all, controls of electric and water are situated.

The infinity pool is 13 metres wide and maximum 1.7 metres deep at the deepest. The 'infinity aspect' is quite special for the view down the valley. The villa is situated just high enough to be where all the birds fly but still only ten minutes walk from the village.

There are saddleback crows, seagulls, swallows, the odd owl, and occasional harrier type birds. There is an electronically controlled gate at the bottom of the driveway for security and the approach road from the main road is relatively obscure and little used.

Local dive centres offer trips to nearby reefs, caves and islands, and you can hire gear if you'd rather go at your own pace. It's a great way to enjoy the Ionian's marine life and hidden underwater landscapes.



Explore further afield

You can take a ferry to the islands of Meganisi, Ithaka and Kefalonia from several different ports on Lefkas.
